Music Memory in the Schools

The audio CDs include two performances of each selected piece: solo part with an orchestrated accompaniment and orchestrated accompaniments alone. The MIDI disks can be used in any MIDI keyboard that has a disk drive or with a personal computer -- control the tempo, transpose to a different key, add a metronome click, and much more. Level 3 also includes a special computer software program called Home Concert 2000 Special Edition(tm) from TimeWarp Technologies. This program shows the student's part on the computer screen, "turns pages" automatically, adjusts tempo and dynamics to match the student's playing (if the keyboard is connected to the computer), and includes many other educational features.

World's Greatest Classic Themes

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This is, without a doubt, the most often played processional at graduations from elementary school through to college and university. Only the main theme has been adapted here and there are several "escapes" if the piece is required to end early. In fact, with all the optional endings, the piece can end just before the 1 minute mark or can be extended to just over 2 minutes or even longer if repeats are taken.

Edward Elgar (1857-1934) is undoubtedly one of the most fascinating, important, and influential figures in the history of British music. He rose from humble beginnings and achieved fame with music that to this day is beloved by audiences in England, and his work has secured an enduring legacy worldwide. Leading scholars examine the composer's life in *Edward Elgar and His World*, presenting a comprehensive portrait of both the man and the age in which he lived. Published in conjunction with the 2007 Bard Music Festival and the 150th anniversary of Elgar's birth, this elegant and thought-provoking volume illuminates the greatness of this accomplished English composer and brings vividly to life the rich panorama of Victorian and Edwardian Britain.
